

Chromebook OpenVPN Setup

Before you begin setting up your Datho VPN connection on the Chromebook download the configuration file, unzip the download and upload it to your Google Drive:

1. Once the certificate is installed on Google Drive inside Chrome go to `chrome://settings/certificates`.
2. Click on the Authorities tab.
3. Click Import (found underneath the certificate list).
4. Navigate to your Google Drive, select the `datho.crt` or `vpn.crt` depending on your subscription plan.
5. Leave the trust settings unchecked and click ok.
6. Click done.
7. Now in the `chrome://settings` tab click Add connection.
8. Select Add private network.

9. In the box that appears, fill in the information below:

Server hostname: add in the full server hostname. (ex: `lax-a03.wlvpn.com`)

Service name: This can be anything you want to name this connection, for example, "Datho VPN NYC"

Provider type: OpenVPN

Pre-shared key: Leave Blank.

Server CA certificate: Select the VPN certificate from the list.

User certificate: Leave Blank.

Username: Your credentials for connecting to VPN.

Password: Your credentials for connecting to VPN.

OTP: Leave Blank

You can also choose to save the password in the checkbox.

Click Connect and you will now connect to the specific server that you setup, if you wish to use a different server you will need to set that up by duplicating the process above.
