

Mac OS X OpenVPN Setup

1. Minimize or suspend any running applications, and activate your main desktop, or 'Finder'. Locate the application dock at the bottom of your screen, and activate the 'Safari' icon (or your favorite web browser) to continue to the next step.
2. Now, open Tunnelblick. Within the Tunnelblick home page, look for the navigation bar, and click the 'Downloads' link. Click on the link for the latest stable release for your specific operating system version. For 10.8 and below currently 3.3.4 and for 10.9 and above currently 3.4Beta28 and continue to the next step.
3. To begin the download, if you're on 10.8 or lower click the link labeled Tunnelblick_3.3.4.dmg, if you're on 10.9 or higher (Mavericks or Yosemite) click the link labeled Tunnelblick 3.4beta28 look for the 'Downloads' dialog, with the progress indicated below the newly added file. Once the download completes, find the downloaded item in the 'Downloads' dialog, and double-click to continue to the next step.
4. At this point, the Tunnelblick download should have been mounted as a disk, and the root directory focused in Finder. Next, execute the Tunnelblick installer by clicking the labeled icon below the words, 'Double-click to begin', and move to the next step.
5. Depending on your system security settings, the dialogs below may appear upon execution of the 'Tunnelblick' installer. Confirm your decision to begin the installation by clicking the 'Open' button.
6. Following your selection, you will be prompted for Administrator credentials - enter the 'Name' and the password associated with that account, then click the 'OK' button to continue to the next step.
7. When the installer completes, the dialog below featuring the title, 'Installation succeeded'. You may choose to launch the newly installed application by clicking the 'Launch' button. Verify that you want to open the file by clicking the 'Open' button and continue to the next step.
8. Download the Datho VPN Tunnelblick configuration file (<http://www.dathovpn.com/download-vpn-software/configs>) . Simply click on the previous link to start the download. You can also find this download on the Downloads page Under the Mac OS X Tunnelblick Configuration section. Once the download completes, find the 'DathoVPN.dmg' item in the 'Downloads' dialog, and double-click to continue to the next step.
9. Once DathoVPN loads as a disk drive double click on the drive icon and double click on DathoVPN-Install.
10. A dialogue will pop up mentioning that administrator privileges are needed. Click on "OK" and continue to the next step.

11. You will be asked to enter your system administrator's credentials and password. Once entered click on OK and continue.

12. If you have previously been using Tunnelblick for other VPN networks you will be prompted to merge those older settings with the new Datho VPN settings. If you choose not to merge them the previous VPN settings will be lost. If you did not have any previous VPN networks setup within Tunnelblick you will not be presented this dialog and can move to the next step.

13. You will get verification that the installation of the configuration files is complete. Click OK and continue to the next step.

14. Administrative privileges may again be requested, and as before enter in the name and password of your admin account, then click the 'OK' button and move to the next step.

15. You will now see the Tunnelblick icon at the top right of your screen, click on the icon and select the Datho VPN location you wish to connect to.

16. You will again be prompted for credentials, however this time, DathoVPN credentials are requested by Tunnelblick. Enter your username and password EXACTLY as you provided them during sign-up - if a single letter is miscapitalized, you will receive an error message. If you wish to save your credentials, tick the checkbox labeled 'Save in Keychain'. Once you are finished, click the 'OK' button to continue. You will need to enter these login credentials for each location you wish to connect to

17. If you have the 'Growl' notification system installed to your Mac, you may see notification messages appear near the Tunnelblick icon in the upper-right corner of your screen. Look for the 'Connected' messages once the tunnel has been successfully initialized. If you noticed any error or warning messages, please record them and contact our support team for further assistance. Verify the connection by checking your email, or by browsing to your favorite website and have assurance that your online activities are shielded from prying eyes. If later on you wish to switch to a different location or disconnect from DathoVPN simply click on the Tunnelblick icon and select disconnect.
