

iPad OpenVPN Setup

Download and install the OpenVPN Connect client from the App Store.

1. Download the Datho VPN Configuration files from:

FREE Users: <http://www.dathovpn.com/downloads/configs/freeplanconfigs.zip>

PAID Users: <http://www.dathovpn.com/downloads/configs/paidplanconfigs.zip>

2. Unzip the downloaded zip file

3. Each server has it's own configuration file and will end in .ovpn. Select the server you want to connect to as well as the certificate file, datho.crt or vpn.crt depending on your subscription plan.

4. You will now need to transfer the .ovpn file and the .crt file into the OpenVPN iOS app. Connect your iOS device to your computer and select it in iTunes.

5. Click Apps.

6. Scroll down to File Sharing, from the list on the left, select the OpenVPN app on your device.

7. From the list on the right, click "Add", navigate to where the .ovpn and .crt file are located, select the files you want to transfer, and click "Sync."

8. Launch the OpenVPN app,

9. You will see the name of the server you just added and below it a green plus sign button. Click on that button.

10. A prompt will appear asking for your Username and Password. You can choose to save the password by selecting the "Save" toggle switch. After completing the password click on the return button on the keyboard.

11. You are now connected to Datho VPN on an iOS device with OpenVPN.
